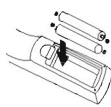
Remote Control Preparation

Battery installation

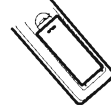
1. Open the cover.



2. Install batteries.

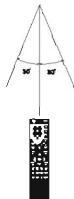

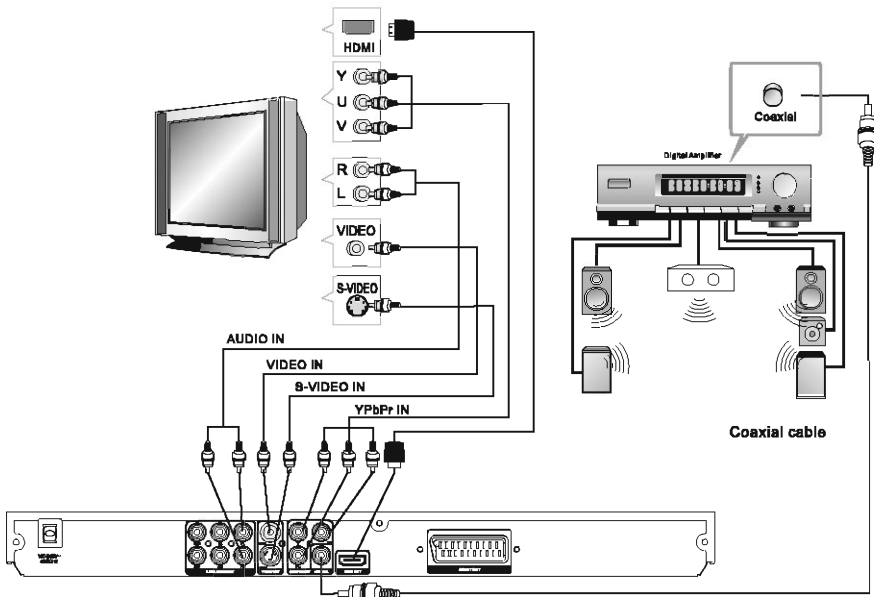
Using the remote

Point the remote control at the remote sensor.
(The pictures below are for reference only.)



Notes:

- Point the remote control directly at the player's remote sensor.
- Do not leave the remote control in an extremely hot or humid place.
- Do not spill water or put anything wet on the remote control.
- Inserting the 2 x AAA 1.5V batteries making sure the polarity (+ or -) of the batteries matches the polarity marks inside the unit.



● **CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO TV SET BY AV CABLE**

Connect the DVD player's FR and FL jack the audio input jack on the TV.

● **CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO TV SET BY S-VIDEO SOCKET**

Use the S-VIDEO cable (not supplied) to connect DVD player and your TV. Set the [Video Type] to [S-Video].

● **CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO TV SET WITH SCART SOCKET**

Use the SCART cable (not supplied) to connect DVD player and your TV. Set the [Video Type] to [TV-RGB].

● **CONNECT THE DVD TO A TV USING THE Y/Pb/Pr JACKS**

Use the COMPONENT Cable (not supplied) to connect DVD player to your TV. Set the [Video Type] to [YUV]. For Progressive Scan, set to [Y,Pb,Pr]. [YUV] and [Y,Pb,Pr] signal is transferred through same jack. If the TV set supports P-scan function, you can set [Video Type] to [Y,Pb,Pr]. If not, you can set [Video Type] to [YUV].

● **Connecting to an AV Amplifier with Digital Audio Input**

Notes:

1. Select the Coaxial digital audio output.
2. Set the player's Audio out to Raw or PCM mode .
3. Set the digital Amplifier to the AV input connected to the DVD player.

SYSTEM SETUP

DVD menu setup

Press the **SETUP** button on the remote control, the SETUP MENU(main) will be displayed.

After accessing the setup menu, press the direction buttons for up and down movement to select an item desired, then press the **ENTER** button to confirm. Press **LEFT** direction button return to the menu of upper level.

To exit the setup, press the **SETUP** button again. In the SETUP MENU, you may choose any of the following options as you like.

Aspect Ratio

4:3PS/4:3LB : Choosing this setting if your DVD player is connected to a normal ratio TV. You can fill the movie to the entire screen of your TV. This might mean that parts of the picture (the left and right edges) won't be seen.

16:9 : Choose this setting if your DVD player is connected to a wide screen TV. If you choose this setting and you don't have a side screen TV, the images on the screen may appear distorted due to vertical compression.

Notes:

The image display ratio is related to the recorded disc format. Some disc can not display images in the aspect ratio you choose. If you play a disc recorded in 4:3 format on a wide screen TV, black bars will appear on the left and right side of the screen. You must adjust the screen setting depending on the type of the television you have.

TV System

This product supports output of various system, including **Multi**, **NTSC**, **PAL**. If your TV set has only **NTSC** or **PAL** system, the screen will blink and become colorless when a wrong system is selected.

Note: For more information of output format, refer to the instructions or your TV set.

Video Output

When DVD player is not connected to TV through HDMI cable, selecting the Video Output setting to switch between different video outputs.

S-VIDEO : Set the video output to S-VIDEO output.

COMPONENT: Set the video output to YUV output.

P-SCAN: If your TV is progressive TV, please select the option. You can get better picture quality.

RGB: Set the video output to SCART output. If you select SCART connection, you should set up the play mode as **RGB** state, then it will output normally.

When DVD player is connected to TV through HDMI cable, the Video Output setting will be changed to P-SCAN automatically.

Adjust display effect for video output:

Standard: default effect.

Bright: internal setting for bright view effect.

Soft: internal setting for soft view effect.

Dynamic: user adjust brightness, contrast, color etc.

HD Resolution

After you set the video output to HDMI output, you can choose the mode of HDMI output: Auto, 480p/576p, 720p, 1080i, 1080p.

Analog output

Analog out select 5.1CH or 2.0CH(select down mix) audio output.

Digital output

Selecting the **Digital Output** setting allows the user to adjust the audio output on S/PDIF ports to work in harmony with the audio equipment(e.g.receiver, speakers)connected to the player.

Off Digital audio output is disabled.

PCM Select this option when you are going to use stereo signals(2 channels). You should combine this option with the option **Lower sampling rate**, Which we explain further on.

RAW If you select this option the player will use the DVD original audio track. Use this option when you want to use the Dolby Digital Ac3 signals through the coaxial audio output.

Test Tones

Selecting the **Test Tone** setting allows the user to test the player's audio output on each speaker. When you select channel, a short burst of pink noise will be sent to corresponding channel.

Down sampling

Down sampling:

ON: system will down sampling rate for high sampling rate audio (more than 96K).

OFF: as normal, may be can play high sampling rate audio.

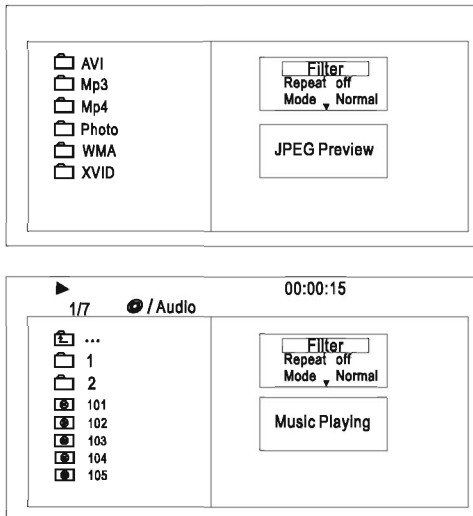

MP3/WMA/MPEG4 PLAYING



The MP3/WMA/MPEG4 disc has such a directory structure as shown in the picture above. Press **Direction key** to choose the root directory and then press **ENTER** button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired track and then press **ENTER** or **PLAY** to enjoy the music or movie. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction key** to choose  the icon and press **ENTER** button.

Filter: Allows selecting the categories of files displayed in the browser list.

This selection is done among the 3 categories: Audio, Photo and Video.

Repeat: To switch different repeat playing mode

Mode: Select different playing mode

Normal: Shuffle mode is cancelled

Shuffle: Shuffle mode enabled. When playback reaches the end of the current chapter/track, playback jumps to a random chapter/track. As the end of each chapter/track is reached, another random chapter/track will be played until all tracks/chapters have been played or the Shuffle mode is cancelled by toggling to a different Mode Option.

Music Intro: In this mode, the media will play 10 seconds then skip to next media.

*Edit Mode: To enable programmed playback mode. When you select the mode, press **LEFT Direction key** to directory and press **ENTER** to choose the desired track and press **Add to program** to start program playback.*

Program view: Display program track

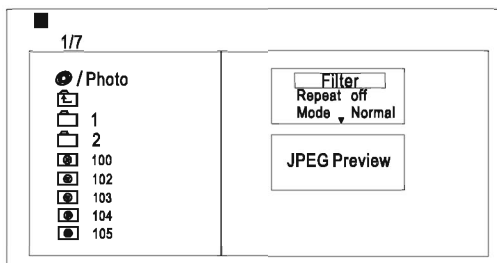
Browser view: Display track directory

*Add to program: Choose the track press **Add to program** to add the track of the program play directory*

*Clear program: In the complete stop state (press the **STOP** button twice), choose the track press **Clear program** to delete the track of the program play directory.*

PICTURE CD PLAYBACK

The PICTURE CD disc has such a directory structure as shown in the following picture.



Press **Direction key** to choose the root directory and then press ENTER button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired picture and then press ENTER or PLAY to enjoy the picture. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction key** to choose the icon and press ENTER button.

Image rotation

In picture playstate, press **Direction key** to rotation the picture, press ANGLE button to change the picture scan mode.

FUNCTION OF USB

3 In 1 Card Reader Function

This unit have a 3 in 1 card jack, when no disc in the player. You can insert (MMC, SD, MS) three kinds of card with card port interface to play the mp3 music or MPEG4 movie and JPEG files. All the function is the same to play a disc.

USB interface

This unit have a USB jack, when no disc in the player, you can insert a USB device or a Mp3 Player with USB Interface to play the Mp3 music or and JPEG files. All the function is the same to play a disc. When the disc is in the player at the stop state, user can enjoy USB by selecting USB in the remote control USB/CARD. Not all USB Device can be supported by this system.

NOTE:

When using USB function. Please do not insert in the wrong direction, or it will be corrupted.

If you have any questions, please consult the troubleshooting guide below.

NO PICTURE OR SOUND

- Ensure the power button is on.
- Ensure the power outlet is operational.
- Ensure the power cord is not damaged.
- Ensure the power plug is connected firmly to the outlet.

PICTURE BUT NO SOUND

- Ensure the audio jacks are securely connected.
- Ensure the audio connector is not damaged.
- Ensure the volume is turned up in VOL/CH setup.
- Ensure you have set the player's AUDIO settings correctly.
- Ensure you have entered the correct AV Input for your TV.
- Ensure the audio is not set to mute.

SOUND BUT NO PICTURE

- Ensure the video jacks are securely connected.
- Ensure you have entered the correct AV input for your TV.
- Ensure the video connector is not damaged.
- Ensure you have set the player's VIDEO settings correctly.

POOR PICTURE OR SOUND

- Ensure you have set the player's AUDIO settings correctly.
- Ensure the disc is not scratched or stained.
- Ensure the AV connector or the output terminal is not damaged.

"BAD DISC" DISPLAYED
