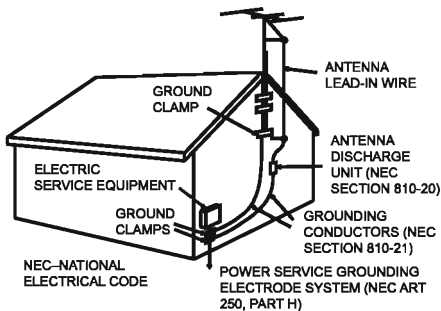

14. Outdoor Antenna Grounding

If an outside antenna or cable system is connected to the product, be sure the antenna or cable system is grounded so as to provide some protection against voltage surges and built-up static charges. Article 810 of the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA 70, provides information in regard to proper grounding of the mast and supporting structure, grounding of the lead-in wire to an antenna discharge unit, size of grounding conductors, location of antenna discharge unit, connection to grounding electrodes, and requirements for the grounding electrode. 15. Lightning

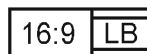

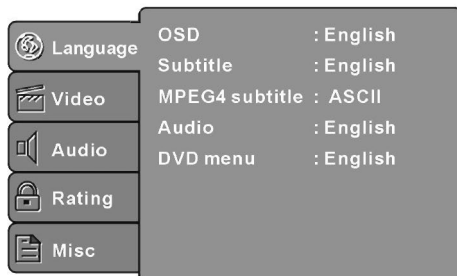

Menu operation

Press the **SETUP** button on the remote control, the **SETUP MENU** will be displayed. After accessing the setup menu, press the direction buttons for up and down movement to select an item desired, then press the **ENTER** button to confirm. Press **LEFT** direction button return to the menu of upper level. To exit the setup, press the **SETUP** button again. In the **SETUP MENU**, you may choose any of the following options as you like.

LANGUAGE SETUP

Select **Language** in the setup menu, and display the **Language** submenu:



OSD

Use this item to select the language of the setup menu and screen display.

Subtitle

This option provides the preset subtitle language.

MPEG4 Subtitle (optional)

Select different MPEG4 subtitle encoding option.

Note: Not all players support this item.

Audio

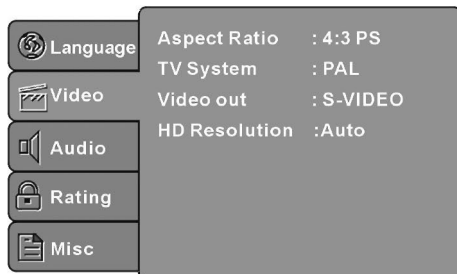
Select the built-in disc dubbing language options.

DVD Menu

This option provides the film's menu language options.

VIDEO SETUP

Select **Video** in the setup menu, and display the **Video** submenu:



Menu operation

Aspect Ratio

Select the aspect ratio.

Note:

The image display ratio is related to the recorded disc format. Some disc can not display images in the aspect ratio you choose. If you play a disc recorded in 4:3 format on a wide screen TV, black bars will appear on the left and right side of the screen. You must adjust the screen setting depending on the type of the television you have.

TV system

Select the different TV system.

Note: The DVD player setting should be matched to your TV set.

For more information of output format, refer to the instructions of your TV set.

Video out

Select the video output format wanted.

Note: Only HDMI DVD player has "HD" selection.

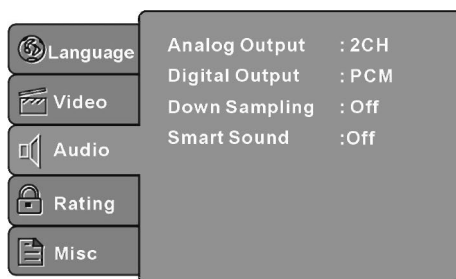
HD Resolution

After you set the video output to HD output, you can choose the resolution of HDMI output.

Note: Only HDMI DVD player has this item.

AUDIO

Select **Audio** in the setup menu, and display the **Audio** submenu.



Analog output (Optional)

Analog out select 5.1CH or 2.0 CH (select down mix) audio output.

Note: This item is only for 5.1ch player.

Menu operation

Digital output (Optional)

Adjust the audio output on Coaxial ports to work in harmony with the audio equipment (e.g.receiver, amplifier) connected to the player.

Off Digital audio output is disabled.

PCM Transfer stereo 2 channels signals

RAW Transfer the DVD original audio track

Note: This item is only for the player with coaxial output.

Down sampling

Select down sampling function on or off.

ON: System will down sampling rate for high sampling rate audio (more than 96K).

OFF: Disable this function.

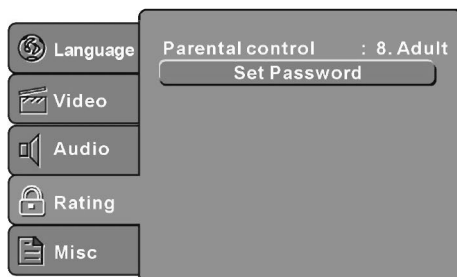
Smart sound (Optional)

Set password

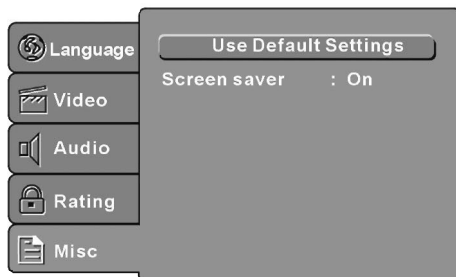
Input four digits (password), then press **ENTER** to confirm.

Select **MISC** in the setup menu, and display the submenu:



Use Default Settings

Reset setup data to factory default value.


Screen Saver (Optional)

Enable/disable the screen saver function.

Note: *Not all player has this item.*

MP3/WMA/JPEG/MPEG4 playback



The MP3/WMA/MPEG4 disc has such a directory structure as shown picture above. Press **Direction** key to choose the root directory and then press **ENTER** button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired track and then press **ENTER** or **PLAY** to enjoy the music or movie. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction** key to choose  the icon and press **ENTER** button.

Filter: Allows selecting the categories of files displayed in the browser list.

Repeat: To switch different repeat playing mode

Mode: Select different playing mode as follows:

Normal: Shuffle mode is cancelled.

Shuffle: Shuffle mode enabled. When playback reaches the end of the current chapter/track, playback jumps to a random chapter/track. As the end of each chapter/track is reached, another random chapter/track will be played until all tracks/chapters have been played or the Shuffle mode is cancelled by toggling to a different **Mode** Option.

Music Intro: In this mode, the media will play 10 seconds then skip to next media.

Edit Mode: To enable programmed playback mode. When you select the mode, press **LEFT Direction key** to directory and press **ENTER** to choose the desired track and press **Add to program** to start program playback.

Program view: Display program track.

Brower view: Display track directory.

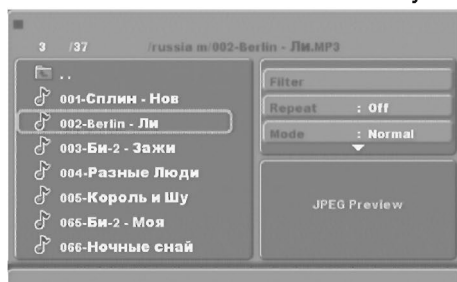
MP3/WMA/JPEG/MPEG4 playback

*Add to program: Choice the track press **Add to program** to add the track of the program play directory.*

*Clear program: In the complete stop state (press the **STOP** button twice), choose the track press **Clear program** to delete the track of the program play directory.*

PICTURE CD PLAYBACK

The PICTURE CD disc has such a directory structure as shown in the following picture.




Press **Direction key** to choose the root directory and then press **ENTER** button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired picture and then press **ENTER** or **PLAY** to enjoy the picture. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction key** to choose  the icon and press **ENTER** button.

Image rotation

In picture play state, press **Direction key** to rotate the picture, press **ANGLE** button to change the picture scan mode.

Card reader ,USB, karaoke (optional)

Note: *Not all player has these items*

3 In 1 Card Reader

If the player has a 3 in1 card jack and it's NOT in "disc playing" status, you can insert three kinds of card (MMC, SD, MS) to play the MP3 music or MPEG4 movie and JPEG files. All the function is the same to playing a disc.

USB

If the player has a USB slot and it's NOT in "disc playing" status, you can insert a USB device or a MP3 Player with USB Interface to play the MP3 music or and JPEG files. All the function is the same to play a disc.

Note: *When inserting the USB device, please do not insert in the wrong direction. Otherwise the USB device or player may be damaged*

When the disc is playing, please stop playing first and then enjoy USB by press USB(/CARD) key on the remote control.

Not all USB device can be supported by this system.

KARAOKE

1. Connecting to microphone
Please insert your microphone to the MIC jack on the front panel.or rear panel.
2. Start.
 - A. Put the DVD or VCD disc in the tray.
 - B. Press the KARAOKE button on the remote control to select function.

Note: *Please set karaoke off if you want 5.1CH audio output when playing 5.1CH disc.*

Troubleshooting

If you have any questions, please consult the troubleshooting guide below.

NO PICTURE OR SOUND

- ▲ Ensure the power button is on.
- ▲ Ensure the power outlet is operational.
- ▲ Ensure the power cord is not damaged.
- ▲ Ensure the power plug is connected firmly to the outlet.

PICTURE BUT NO SOUND

- ▲ Ensure the audio jacks are securely connected.
- ▲ Ensure the audio connector is not damaged.
- ▲ Ensure the volume is turned up in VOUCH setup.
- ▲ Ensure you have set the player's AUDIO settings correctly.
- ▲ Ensure you have entered the correct AV input for your TV
- ▲ Ensure the audio is not set to mute.

SOUND BUT NO PICTURE

- ▲ Ensure the video jacks are securely connected.
- ▲ Ensure you have entered the correct AV input for your TV
- ▲ Ensure the video connector is not damaged.
- ▲ Ensure you have set the player's VIDEO settings correctly.

POOR PICTURE OR SOUND

- ▲ Ensure you have set the player's AUDIO settings correctly.
- ▲ Ensure the disc is not scratched or stained.
- ▲ Ensure the AV connector or the output terminal is not damaged.

„BAD DISC“ DISPLAYED

- ▲ Ensure the disc is not warped, damaged or deformed.
- ▲ Ensure the disc is not badly stained or damaged.
- ▲ Ensure the disc format is compatible with the player.
