IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

- Carefully unpack the product, and take care not to throw away any part of the packaging material before you have found all parts of the product.
- 2) This baby monitor is designed as an aid and must not be used a full replacement for proper supervision of a responsible adult.
- 3) Ensure that the baby unit and the adapter cable are always out of the child's reach (a distance of at least 1m).
- 4) Never place the baby unit into the baby's bed or the baby's enclosure.
- 5) It is not permitted to make construction changes to the product nor to attach HF amplifiers or antennas.
- 6) This appliance must not be used by persons (including children) with physical or mental impairments or by inexperienced persons, unless properly trained or schooled in the safe use of the appliance, or unless they have been properly supervised by a qualified person who will be responsible for their safety.
- 7) Never use accessories that have not been delivered with this product or are not intended for it.
- 8) Under no circumstances should you try to repair or amend the appliance on your own danger of electric shock! Entrust all repairs and adjustments to a specialised company/service. If you tamper with the product during the warranty period, you run the risk of voiding the warranty.
- 9) Only store and use the appliance away from flammable or volatile materials and solutions.

SET UP

1. Turn on the baby's unit




The baby's unit uses either 4 alkaline AA batteries or alternate current from the mains.




OPERATION FROM THE MAINS


 Insert the power cable into the socket on the side of the baby's unit.



2. Connect the other end to the power socket.



After connecting to the mains the LED Power indicator (Power) will turn green.






Use only the power adapter supplied. By using a wrong adapter you may irreparably damage the baby's unit.



BATTERY OPERATION


The baby's unit may also be powered using batteries so that it is possible to use it in places far away from the power socket or during a power outage.



1. Remove the battery compartment cover and insert 4x alkaline AA batteries into the battery compartment of the baby's unit. then return the battery compartment cover to its place.



2. The green LED power indicator (Power) will turn on.



Caution:


- We recommend the use of 4 x alkaline AA batteries.
- The baby's unit will be powered using the batteries only when it is disconnected from the mains,
- Discharged batteries: The LED power indicator on the baby's unit will flash and the LED link indicator on the parent's unit will flash red.
- Before disconnecting from the mains or removing the batteries, please turn off the baby's unit.

2. Set up the parent's unit

2.1 Power Supply


The parent's unit uses 2x rechargeable AAA batteries.




BATTERY OPERATION

 Remove the battery compartment cover and insert 2x rechargeable AAA batteries into the battery compartment of the parent's unit, then return the battery compartment cover to its place - see picture.

You should ensure that there are always batteries in the parent's unit.








Caution:


Never use non-rechargeable batteries in the parent's unit. Use only 2x rechargeable AAA batteries - using any other type may cause irreparable damage to the unit.

2. Connect the recharger for the parent's unit into a mains power socket.











Caution:

Use only the power adapter supplied. By using a wrong adapter you may irreparably damage the recharger.

3. Insert the parent's unit into the recharger - the recharger indicator will be red, this will occur even when the parent's unit is not in the recharger.





4. If the batteries become discharged the LED power indicator on the parent's unit will flash green. After starting to recharge, it will beep twice and the indicator will flash orange. Once fully recharged the indicator will turn off.




Caution:

- Before using this baby monitor for the first time, charge the parent's unit for a time of at least 8 hours.
- In the recharger indicator is not on, you must insert or replace the batteries.
- If any of the following situations occurs it is necessary to recharge or the replace the batteries:
 LED recharge indicator does not turn on.
 - Discharged batteries: LED recharge indicator is flashing.
- When the parent's unit is in the recharger, it is still possible to use it.
- Before removing the batteries, please turn off the unit.

1.2 Belt clip


To improve comfort you may attach the belt clip.



3. Check the link

When both units are turned on a green link indicator turns on on both units. If at any time the link between the units is cut off, the link indicators on both units will turn red. On the parent's unit you will also hear a warning signal, which informs you about the loss of the link between the units. If this situation occurs, check that the baby's unit is connected to the mains and whether the baby's unit is turned on.


Also check that the units are within each others range.


OPERATION OF THE BABY'S UNIT

Place both units in the same room to check the link. Ensure that the baby's unit is at least 1 m away from the parent's unit.



Note:


If you place the parent's and baby's units too close to one another, you will hear a high tone sound - do not be concerned by this, the device is working correctly. The units are designed so that they may be placed at a certain distance from one another, e.g. in separate rooms. In such a situation place the units further from each other.




1. Volume Adjustment button

On the parent's or baby's unit:

- On each unit there are 5 volume levels available.
- Press button
 • to turn up the volume or button
 • to turn down the volume. Changing the volume setup of the baby's unit affects the volume when using the Talk Back function (two way communication).

2. Mute mode and setting microphone sensitivity


When setting the sensitivity do the following:


Press the Mute button on the parent's unit and then within 3 seconds press button ⊕ or ⊕ to select the required sensitivity level – 1 for low sensitivity (Low) up to 5 for high sensitivity (High) (factory setting is 3).

Note 1: If you press and hold button ⊕ or ⊕, the sensitivity level will change automatically.

Note 2: When changing to Mute mode the LED indicator should turn on at level 4.


Note 3: To return to normal mode press the Mute button again.





3. Talk Back function (Two way communication)

The Talk Back Function (Two way communication) may be used to comfort or to calm down your baby.







- If you wish to talk to your baby, press and hold the Talk button on the parent's unit.
- If you want to hear your baby again, release the Talk button.

4. Night time light

The night time light provides your baby with a gentle and relaxing light, making it possible to check your baby without having to turn on the main light in the room.






Press the Light button on the baby's unit. By pressing it again you can turn off this function.

5. Volume level indication

Volume level indicators are green and red indicators located in the upper part of the parent's unit, which are turned on depending on the sound level in the baby's room.

There are 8 volume levels available:

- Level 0: 0 green indicators
- Level 1: 1 green indicator
- Level 2: 2 green indicators
- Level 3: 3 green indicators
- Level 4: 4 green indicators
- Level 5: 5 green indicators
- Level 6: 5 green indicators and 1 red indicator
- Level 7: 5 green indicators and 2 red indicators

TROUBLESHOOTING

Power indicator does not turn on:

- If you are using mains power adapters, check that they are connected to the mains and turned on.
- If you are using batteries, check that they are correctly inserted and whether they are not discharged.

Link indicator (Link) is not on:

- Check that the baby's unit and the parent's unit are turned on.
- If you are using batteries, check that they are correctly inserted and whether they are not discharged.

Link indicator (Link) is red:

The link between your units has been lost. You will also hear a warning signal, which alerts you
to the loss of communication between the units. If this situation occurs, check that the power
adapters (batteries) are connected correctly and whether the units are with range of each other.

The parent's unit remains silent or is very quiet:

- The volume may be set to a level that is too low.
- Maybe the Mute button has been pressed

A high tone sound is being produced:

- The units are too close to each other or the volume is set to a level that is too high.
- Move the parent's unit further away from the baby's unit (at least 1 m).
- Lower the volume on the parent's unit.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Caution:

Before cleaning, always disconnect this device from the power source.

To clean the outer parts of the product, use a soft cloth dipped in lukewarm water. Do not use aggressive cleaning agents, paint thinners or solvents. Using these solutions could damage the surface of the iron

DISPOSAL OF USED BATTERIES

This product comes with one alkaline battery. Do not place used batteries into regular household waste.
