

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

- This product must not be used by persons (including children) with physical or mental impairments or by inexperienced persons, unless properly trained or schooled in the safe use of the product, or unless they have been properly supervised by a qualified person who will be responsible for their safety.

- 13) Do not disconnect the power cord from the wall outlet by pulling the cord.
- 14) Do not submerge the product in water or in any other liquid.
- 15) If you are not using the product, or if you know that you will not be using it soon, turn it off and disconnect the power cord from the wall socket. Prior to cleaning, proceed in the same manner.
- 16) Do not touch the water condensation surfaces inside the humidifier with any hard object.
- 17) Do not shake the humidifier, and make sure it does not fall on the floor.
- 18) Never place the humidifier on a sloped surface.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PRODUCT

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Make sure that the humidifier is not connected to the power socket and that the main switch is turned off.
- 2) Remove the water tank from the base of the humidifier.
- 3) Turn the tank so that the bottom is facing upwards, turning left unscrew the tank lock and pour in the required amount of fresh cold water.



Note:

- Do not pour warm water into the tank.
- Never pour water anywhere else than directly into the water tank.
- 4) Screw in the lock by turning right and place the tank back on to the base. Water will immediately start to flow into the base.
- 5) Now connect the humidifier using the inflow cable with an adapter to the electrical socket.
- 6) By turning the cover of the steam outflow set the required direction of the steam outflow.
- 7) Now put the humidifier into operation by pressing the main "ON/OFF" switch. A green LED indicator light will turn on.



Note:

- Never remove the water tank if the humidifier is running and connected to the electrical outlet.
- During operation, never touch the water condensation surfaces.

If you have filled the tank to the edge, the expected operation time is 10 hours.

If the water in the tank runs out, the LED indicator light will start flashing red for a few seconds and then the humidifier will turn off.

Function for turning off the water tank light

This humidifier is equipped with the option to turn off the water tank light, which you will appreciate during the night:

- 1 press the ON/OFF button = humidifier on, light off
- 2 press the ON/OFF button = humidifier on, light on
- 3 press the ON/OFF button = humidifier off, light off

Use of aromatic oils

This humidifier makes it possible to use aromatic oils.

- 1) Turn off the humidifier using the main "ON/OFF" switch.
- 2) By pulling upwards remove the cover of the area for the aromatic oils.
- 3) Drip the required amount of aromatic oil onto the absorption pads.
- 4) Place the cover back on the humidifier and put it into operation by pressing the main "ON/OFF" switch.

The absorption pads can later by substituted by a piece of cotton wool or another appropriate absorptive material.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

To clean the individual parts of the product, use a soft cloth dipped in lukewarm water. If scale is present use a vinegar solution. Do not use harsh cleaning fluids, paint thinners or solvents. These can damage the surface of the product. Clean the plate for water condensation preferably using a cotton bud dipped in lukewarm water, or a vinegar solution. If the water chimney becomes clogged, remove its cover and clean out the internal parts using a damp cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Cause	Solution
The power indicator is off, no air is blowing and no steam	The plug is not inserted into the power socket.	Insert the plug correctly into the po- wer socket and turn on the main "ON/ OFF" switch.
The power indicator is on, air is blowing but there is no steam in it.	There is no water in the water tank. The cover of the floater for the detection of the water level has come loose.	Fill up the tank with water. Tighten the tank lock.
An odour in the outflowing steam can be sensed	New humidifier or dirty water.	Open the water tank and place it in the shade for 12 hours. Clean the water tank or change the water.
Power indicator, there is no air blowing and no steam is coming out	The water level is too high.	Pour out some water from the water chimney and firmly screw in the water tank lock.
Insufficient amount of steam	There is scale on the water condensation plate, water is dirty or has not been changed for a long time.	Clean the water condensation plate and replace the old water with new.
The water amount is not declining	The floater has come loose or the cover for water input is dirty.	Pull tight the cover of the floater and clean the cover of the regulator.
