#### **IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE**

- 1) Carefully unpack the product and take care not to throw away any part of the packaging before you find all the parts of the product.
- 2) This product may not be used by any persons (including children) with mental disabilities, weak strength or by inexperienced persons, unless they have been properly trained or schooled in the safe use of the product, or unless they are properly supervised by a qualified person who is responsible for their safety.
- 3) Children must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product.
- 4 Before connecting this product to the socket outlet, make sure the voltage stated on the label of the product corresponds to the voltage in your wall socket.
- 5 Never use accessories, which have not been supplied with this product or which are not designed for this product.
- 6) Do not place the power cord near hot places or sharp objects. Do not place heavy objects on the power cord. Position the cord so that it will not be stepped on or tripped over. Make sure the power cord is not touching a hot surface.
- 7) If the power cord of the product is damaged have it repaired by an authorised service technician to prevent causing a dangerous situation. It is forbidden to use the product if it has a damaged power cord or plug.
- 8) Do not disconnect the power cord from the wall outlet by pulling the cord.
- 9) In no case should you attempt to repair the unit yourself, do not make any amendments to it danger of electric shock! Entrust all repairs and adjustments to a specialised company/service. Failure to do so will expose you to a danger of voiding the warranty policy.
- 10) Never use the product if you have wet hands or feet.
- 11) Only store and use the product away from flammable or volatile materials and solutions.
- 12) Do not use the product for purposes other than those intended.
- 13) Do not spray the product with water or any other liquid. Do not submerge the product in water or in any other liquid.
- 14) If you are not using your machine, disconnect the power cord from the socket.
- 15) If you will not be using the product, turn it off and disconnect the power cord from the wall outlet. Prior to cleaning, proceed in the same manner.
- 16) Never leave the product switched on without supervision.
- 17) In order to avoid deformation or a fire in the plastic components of the vacuum cleaner, do not expose the vacuum to direct sunlight, do not place it close to heaters, open fires or other sources of heat and do not leave the vacuum cleaner operating for too long, if the air inflow is blocked.
- 18) Do not use the product in an environment with excessive dust.
- 19) Use extra care if the product is used near children. Always keep the product out of the reach of children.
- 20) If the product is being used, do not block the air inflow and outflow openings. Blocked air vents can cause overheating and motor damage.
- 21) Vacuuming the below mentioned objects can damage your product or cause injuries to the operating person:
  - any type of sharp objects such as broken glass or ceramics, needles, pins, etc.
  - burning cigarettes, or smouldering pieces, matches or any other flammable or volatile liquids (e.g. gasoline, paint thinners, etc.)
  - flour, cement, plaster (i.e. dust from holes drilled in walls)
- 22) In order to avoid damaging furniture or injuries to persons, hold the power cord in your hands as it winds up.
- 23) Do not vacuum larger pieces of paper or plastic bags. They may easily clog the pipe or hose. In case the vacuum becomes clogged for any reason, turn it off by removing it from the electric socket and clean the pipe or hose.
- 24) In order to avoid damage to the hose, do not step on it or forcefully bend it. Do not use the vacuum if the hose is bent or damaged in any other way.
- 25) Do not move over the power cord with the vacuum cleaner.
- 26) Never use the vacuum cleaner without the protective motor filter or the outflow filter.
- 27) Do not place the vacuuming hose, inlet nozzle or vacuuming accessories near to your eyes or ears.



28) Vacuuming of some types of floors or floor surfaces can create a static electricity charge, which is not dangerous for the user.



#### **DESCRIPTION**

#### **ASSEMBLY**

#### Inserting the hose into the air suction hole on the vacuum cleaner.

Insert the hose end into the vacuum cleaner opening and turn to arrest in place. The hose is now secured in correct position.

#### Attach the holder to the telescopic tube:

Make sure to place the holder with the hose on the wider part of the telescopic tube.

#### Attach the floor injet nozzle to the telescopic tube:

Make sure the floor nozzle is attached the narrower part of the telescopic tube.

#### Adjust the length of the telescopic tube:

Adjust the length of the telescopic tube as follows: Move and hold the button on the tube forward as shown the by arrows and adjust the length of the tube as required. Release the button and move the tube slightly forward until you hear a "click". The telescopic tube is now securely fixed in position.

#### **USING YOUR VACUUM CLEANER**

#### Connecting your vacuum cleaner to the electrical power grid

Pull the plug attached to the power cord out from the vacuum cleaner until the desired length of the power cord is out of the product. Insert the plug into the socket.



#### Caution:

Yellow marking on the power cord warns that the power cord is close to its end. Do not pull the power cord further than the red marking.

#### Vacuuming dust

When vacuuming dust, attach a standard floor nozzle on to the telescopic tube and insert a dust bag into the container. Before inserting the dust bag make sure that the container is entirely dry.

You may set the inlet nozzle according to the floor surface by adjusting the inlet flap:

- If you want to vacuum carpets, close the bristles of the inlet inside the inlet nozzle, by turning the flap
  accordingly.
- If you want to vacuum hard and smooth surfaces, move the bristles out of the nozzle, by turning the flap accordingly.

#### Vacuuming water


When vacuuming water attach the special floor nozzle with rubber squeegees (see pic. C) and take the dust bag out of the container. Under no circumstances should you use a carpet nozzle with a metal underside for wet vacuuming - risk of corrosion!

If while vacuuming water, the container becomes fully filled, a safety float will stop the suction and the noise level of the motor will increase dramatically. Further vacuuming is only possible after the container has been emptied.



#### Caution:

- If while vacuuming water the vacuum cleaner tips over, it is necessary to have the vacuum cleaner motor inspected by a service before further use.
- Never use this vacuum cleaner as a full substitution for a pump, i.e. pumping water from tanks, baths, aguariums, etc. The seal on the hose could be damage by the high pressure.
- After finishing vacuuming of water it is necessary to allow the vacuum cleaner to run for another 30 seconds, so that the remaining water is sucked out of the hose and tube.



#### Turning your vacuum cleaner on and off

To switch your machine on or off, press the START / STOP button on the vacuum cleaner body.

#### Adjusting the suction strength

The suction strength may be adjusted by turning the dial on the product's body (small range) or by the moveable flap on the hose handle.



#### Tip

- Use the maximum suction strength when vacuuming carpets or floors with a hard surface. Use the reduced strength when vacuuming upholstery, window curtains, etc.
- If the hose holder becomes blocked when vacuuming, disconnect it from the telescopic tube and also
  disconnect the hose from the vacuum cleaner body. Then place the holder inside the suction hole on
  the vacuum cleaner body and vacuum the stuck dirt out.

#### Temporary interruption of the vacuuming process


If you wish to interrupt vacuuming for a while, you can use the parking position at the back part of the vacuum cleaner, onto which the floor nozzle lug slides on.



#### Note:

Do not move the vacuum cleaner from place to place if the hose is in the parked position! It may break off or the lugs for the floor nozzle or telescopic tube may break off.

#### **USING YOUR ACCESSORIES**



#### **Ending the vacuuming process**

When you finish vacuuming, switch the vacuum cleaner off by pressing the START / STOP button and then disconnect the power cord plug from the socket.

To wind the power back to the vacuum cleaner, press and hold the winding button with one hand. Hold the power cord with your other hand to protect the vacuum cleaner input area from damage



#### Tip:

If the winding process stops and part of the power cord is still outside, release the winding button and pull the power cord out again by about 50 cm and press the winding button again and repeat the winding process.

#### Carrying your vacuum cleaner

If you need to carry the vacuum cleaner, hold it only by the handle.

#### STORAGE OF VACUUM CLEANER

Before storage you may disassemble your vacuum cleaner into its individual parts or you may store it assembled with the telescopic tube arrested in the "parking" position (on the rear side of the vacuum cleaner).


#### **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**



#### Caution:

Before cleaning disconnect this product from the power source.

#### Changing the dust bag / emptying water from the container



1) Press both clips on the sides of the lid at the same time to remove the lid from the body of the vacuum cleaner and place it upside down on a soft surface.



#### Caution:

Do not put down with the lid of the motor cover facing downwards!

- 2) If you were vacuuming with the dust bag pull upwards to remove the full dust bag and replace it with a new one.
- 3) If you were vacuuming water (without a dust bag) empty the water down the drain.
- 4) Put the cover over the container until you hear a click on both sides.




#### Caution:

If after vacuuming water you decide to vacuum with the dust bag again, it is necessary to first thoroughly dry the container.

#### Changing and cleaning the foam inflow filter.



1) Press both clips on the sides of the lid at the same time to remove the lid from the body of the vacuum cleaner and place it upside down on a soft surface.




#### Caution:

Do not put down with the lid of the motor cover facing downwards!

- 2) Now remove the foam filter from the motor cover and wash it under lukewarm running water. Remember that it is necessary to thoroughly dry the filter before putting it back on the motor cover. In the case of heavy soiling replace it with a new one.
- 3) Put the cover over the container until you hear a click on both sides.

#### Changing the outflow filter



- First take off the cover of the outflow filter by pressing the cover clip downwards and tipping it out of the body of the vacuum cleaner.
- 2) Then remove the outflow filter and replace with a new one.
- 3) Close the cover again in its place until the clip clicks in.



#### Caution:

Make sure you put the inflow filter in the vacuum cleaner with the plastic grill facing outwards!

#### Cleaning your vacuum cleaner.

To clean the outside parts of the product use a fine cloth dipped in lukewarm water. Do not use aggressive cleaning agents, paint thinners or solvents. Using these solutions could damage the surface of the product.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Before you decide to contact an authorized service centre, please read these following tips in the troubleshooting chart:
