- Before connecting this appliance to a power socket, make sure the rated voltage stated on its rating label corresponds to the voltage in your power socket.
- Do not place the appliance on an electric or gas stove or in its vicinity, on the edge of a table or on an unstable surface. Only place the appliance on an even, dry and stable surface.
- Only use the appliance with the original accessories that came with it. The containers that are part of this appliance's accessories are not intended for heating food in a microwave oven.
- Do not fill the blending jars past their maximum nominal capacity.
- Always prior to attaching an assembled blending jar to the motor unit, make sure that the blade assembly is properly attached to the blending jar as this will prevent the liquids contained in the jar from leaking out.
- Be especially careful when handling hot foods and liquids. Hot steam or splashing hot foods and liquids may cause scalding. Do not pour liquids hotter than 80 °C into the blending jar. For reasons of increased safety, it is recommended to allow hot liquids to cool down before blending them.
- Do not attempt to blend hard fruit stones that are contained in for example apricots, peaches, mangoes, avocados, etc., nut shells, bones, etc.
- Frequent blending of dry ingredients such as for example grains, results in excessive wear of the blade assembly and impacts the appearance of the blending jar.
- Do not leave the appliance in continuous operation for longer than 1 minute. Before turning it on again, allow it to cool down for at least 5 minutes.
- The appliance is equipped with a thermal fuse that protects the motor against damage in case of overload. If the appliance shuts off as a consequence of the motor being overloaded, disconnect it from the power socket and allow it cool for at least 15 minutes. Then you can put the appliance back into operation.
- Do not turn on the appliance when it is empty. Incorrect use of the appliance may negatively affect its lifetime.

- If ingredients stick to the blade assembly or the inside walls of the blending jar, turn the appliance off and unplug it from the power supply. Make sure that the blade assembly has stopped rotating. Take the blending jar assembly off the motor unit and turn it over so that the blade assembly points upwards. Remove the blade assembly and using a plastic spatula clean the blade assembly and the walls of the blending jar. Reassemble the blending jar and mount it back on the motor unit. Plug the power cord into a power socket and continue blending.
- Do not turn the blending jar while the appliance is running. Before handling the blending jar in any way, first turn off the appliance, unplug it from the power socket and wait for the rotating parts to come to a stop.
- When handling the blade assembly, when taking it out of the blending jar and when cleaning it, take special care to avoid injury on the blades.
- Always turn off the appliance and disconnect it from the power socket if you will not be using it and if you will be leaving it without supervision, before changing accessories, before assembly, disassembly, cleaning and before moving it. Make sure that the rotating parts have come to a complete stop before disassembly.
- Clean it according to the instructions in chapter Cleaning and maintenance. Do not submerge the motor unit and its power cord in water or any other liquid, or wash these parts under running water.
- Ensure that the power plug contacts do not come into contact with moisture. Do not place heavy items on the power cord. Make sure that the power cord does not hang over the edge of a table or that it is not touching a hot surface.

BEFORE FIRST USE

1. Remove all packaging materials, including promotional tags and labels from the appliance and its accessories.
2. Thoroughly wash all removable accessories that are intended to come into contact with food using warm water and a neutral kitchen detergent. Then rinse them with clean water and allow them to dry naturally or dry them out thoroughly using a wiping cloth. All removable parts, except for the blade assembly **A2**, are suitable for washing in a dishwasher (in the upper rack).
3. Do not rinse or submerge the motor unit **A3** or its power cord in water.



Attention:
When cleaning the blade assembly **A2**, be very careful not to injure yourself on its sharp edge.

INTENDED USE OF THE APPLIANCE

- The nutri blender is ideal for making fresh nutritional drinks or smoothies, milkshakes and other cocktails, outstanding salsas, creamy soups, sauces or for blending baby food. It is equipped with two sizes of blending jars, which also serve as practical drinking bottles. The blending jars are made from durable Tritan material. This is a high quality plastic that is characterised by its long lifetime and that it does not absorb any odours or smells. It is resistant against impact and scratching, and is suitable for washing in a dishwasher. The lid with the closable drinking spout makes it possible to easily carry the bottle without spilling the drink. Its anti-slip feet provide excellent stability to the nutri blender during its operation.

ASSEMBLING AND DISASSEMBLING THE APPLIANCE

- Before you start assembling or disassembling the appliance, check that the motor unit **A3** is turned off and disconnected from the power socket and that the rotating parts have come to a complete stop.

1. Assembling and disassembling the blending jar

- 1.1 Turn the blending jar **A1** or **A5** so that its neck points upwards.
- 1.2 Screw the blade assembly **A2** to the neck of the blending jar and make sure that it is firmly tightened. Turn the assembled blending jar so that the blade assembly **A2** points downwards.



Note:
Place food and liquids into the blending jar **A1** or **A5** before attaching the blade assembly **A2** to it.

- 1.3 To disassemble, proceed in the reverse sequence.
2. **Attaching the blending jar to the motor unit and its removal**

- 2.1 Place the motor unit **A3** on an even, dry surface, for example on a kitchen countertop. Place the assembled blending jar assembly on to the motor unit **A3** from above so that the blade assembly **A2** and the tabs along the outer perimeter of the blending jar slide into the motor unit **A3**. Turn the assembled blending jar assembly clockwise all the way. It will not be possible to turn on the appliance unless the blending jar assembly is properly attached to the motor unit **A3**.
- 2.2 To remove the blending jar assembly from the motor unit **A3**, proceed in the reverse sequence.

3. Assembling the drinking bottle

- To assemble the drinking bottle, screw the lid **A6** on to the neck of the blending jar **A1** or **A5** and tighten firmly. When carrying it, make sure that the drinking spout is properly closed so as not to spill the bottle's contents.

FOOD PREPARATION

- Remove hard stones from fruits such as for example apricots, peaches, mangoes, etc. Remove fruit and vegetable peels depending on whether they are edible or not, and whether they were chemically treated or not. Remove shells from nuts, and bones from meat.
- It is necessary to cut all ingredients of tougher consistency into smaller pieces before placing them in the blending jar **A1** or **A5**.
- You will achieve better blending results if you add at least 200 ml of liquids to ingredients that have a tougher consistency such as fruits and vegetables.
- When preparing various drinks, no more than approximately 10 ice cubes should be added to the blending jar.
- Ice cubes must be blended immediately upon being removed from the freezer. When they start to melt, they will stick together and it will not be possible to blend them.

OPERATING THE APPLIANCE

1. Place the prepared food and liquids into the blending jar **A1** or **A5** and assemble the blender according to the instructions in chapter Assembling and disassembling the appliance.



Attention:
Never fill the blending jar **A1** or **A5** past the maximum mark.

2. Make sure that the speed control **B5** is set to position 1. Connect the motor unit **A3** to a power socket. When the blending jar is correctly attached to the motor unit **A3**, the display **B1** will show "--". This signals that the appliance is switched to the stand-by mode. To activate the control panel, press the button **B6**. "00" will appear on the display **B1**.
3. You can use buttons **B2–B4** to select from the preset blending modes. After pressing the respective button, the selected mode will start and the time remaining to the end of operation will count down on the display **B1**. In a preset mode, the speed is controlled automatically. The setting on the speed control knob **B5** has no effect on the speed. The appliance will automatically stop once the preset time has elapsed. If you wish to pause the appliance during operation, press the "START/PAUSE" button **B7**. To resume operation, press the button **B7** again. If you wish to end the selected mode prematurely, press the button **B6**.

Button selection	Purpose of use	Length of preset mode
Button B2	For making fruit smoothie drinks	50 s
Button B3	For making vegetable smoothie drinks, blending soups, nuts, grains, etc.	60 s
Button B4	For making nutritional drinks, fruit and vegetable purées and baby foods.	40 s


4. If you do not wish to use any of the preset modes, set the desired speed in the range from 1 to 10 using the speed control knob **B5** and start the appliance by pressing the "START/PAUSE" button **B7**. The display **B1** will show the elapsed time. During operation, you may change the speed as necessary. When "60" appears on the display **B1**, the appliance will stop automatically. If you wish to stop the appliance sooner, press the button **B6**. To pause the appliance temporarily or to resume operation, use the "START/PAUSE" button **B7**.

Recommended speed setting	Ingredients
Speed 1–4	Blending of very soft and soft ingredients (oranges, tomatoes, bananas, etc.), liquids, viscous sauces, etc.
Speed 5–7	Blending of harder ingredients such as carrots, etc., boiled grains, beans, soya beans, etc.
Speed 8–10	Blending of hard ingredients such as nuts, dry grains and dry beans, etc.

5. The "PULSE" button **B8** is used for crushing ice and for short pulse blending of smaller amounts of ingredients. When button **B8** is pressed, the appliance will run at maximum speed and the appliance will run as long as the button **B8** is pressed (however, no longer than 1 minute). When button **B8** is released, the appliance will stop.



Attention:
The maximum continuous operating time of the appliance is 1 minute. Then allow the appliance to cool down for 5 minutes.

6. After you have finished using the appliance, set the speed control knob **B5** to position 1, turn off the appliance using the  button **B6** and disconnect the power cord from the power socket. Make sure that the rotating parts have stopped rotating. Take the blending jar assembly off the motor unit **A3**, disassemble the blade assembly **A2** and empty out its contents, or close it using the lid as necessary.
7. Then clean all the used parts according to the instructions in chapter Cleaning and maintenance.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Before cleaning it, make sure that the appliance is turned off, disconnected from the power socket and that the rotating parts have stopped.
- Disassemble the appliance into its individual parts. Thoroughly wash the used accessories using warm water and neutral kitchen detergent. Then rinse them with clean water and allow them to dry naturally or dry them out thoroughly using a wiping cloth. All removable parts, except for the blade assembly **A2**, are suitable for washing in a dishwasher (in the upper rack).



Note:

For cleaning the blade assembly **A2**, you may use the included brush **A7**.



Attention:

When cleaning the blade assembly **A2**, be very careful not to injure yourself on its sharp edge.

- When you have finished using it, it is also possible to clean the appliance by filling the blending jar **A1** or **A5** with clean water with the addition of a few drops of neutral kitchen detergent and running the appliance for 5 to 10 seconds. Then turn off the appliance, disconnect it from the power socket and disassemble it. Then thoroughly rinse the blade assembly **A2** and the blending jar **A1** or **A5** under clean running water and allow it to dry naturally, or wipe it dry.
- To clean the outer surface of the motor unit **A3**, use a cloth lightly dipped in a weak detergent solution. After applying the detergent solution, wipe the surface with a cloth lightly dampened in clean water and then wipe dry.
- Never submerge the motor unit **A3** or the power cord in water or in any other liquid.
- Do not use solvents, cleaning products with an abrasive effect, etc. for cleaning the appliance. Otherwise, the surface coat of the appliance may be damaged.

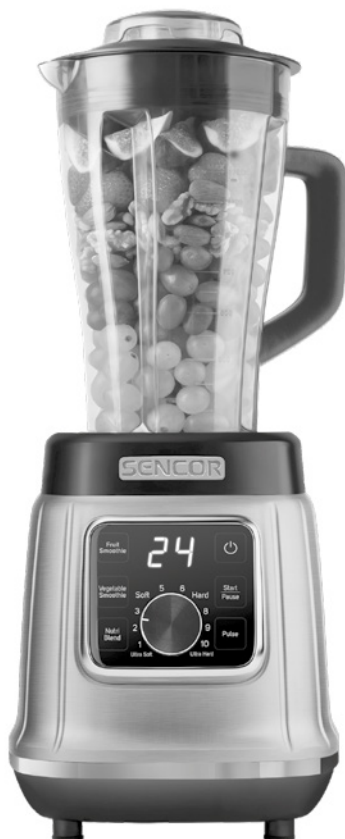

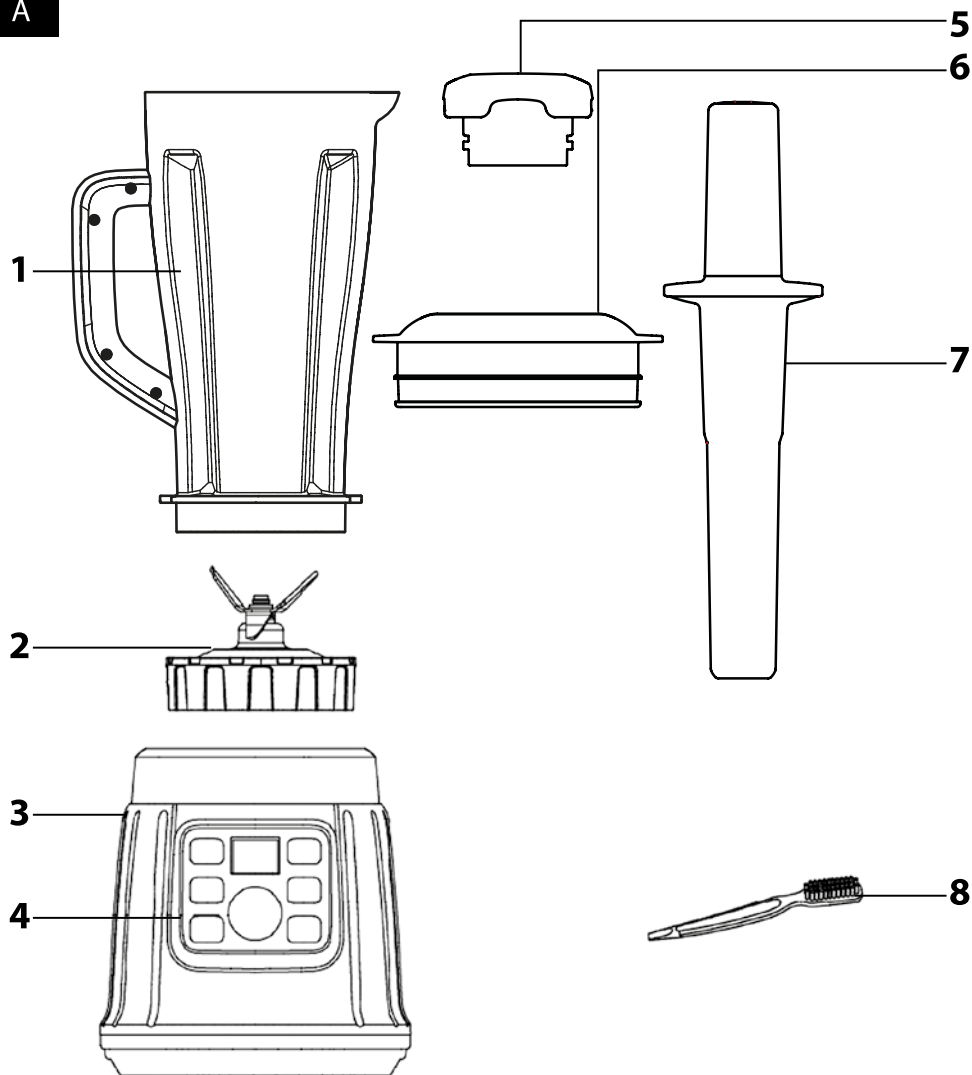

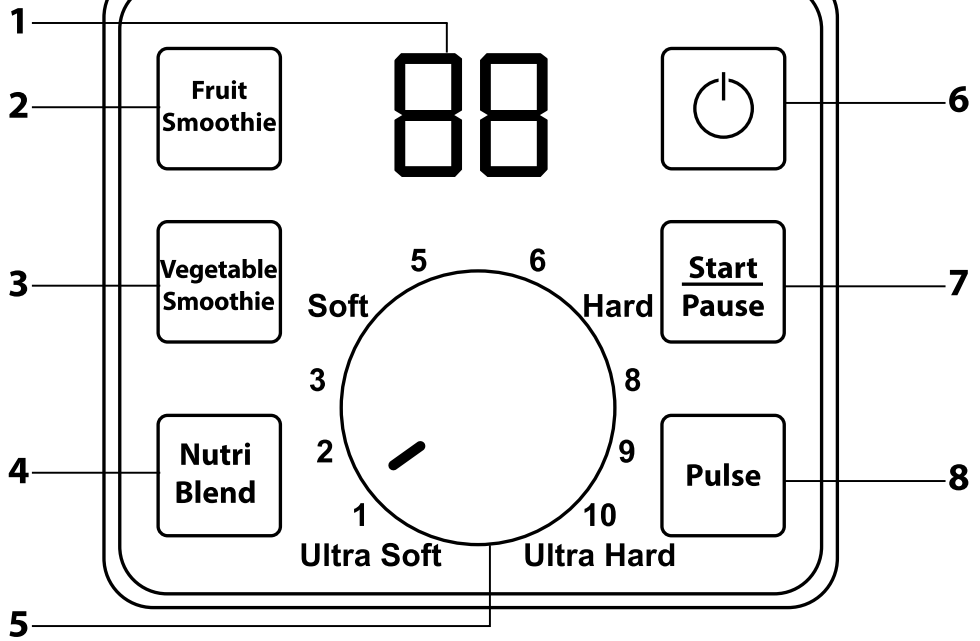

4. If you do not wish to use any of the preset modes, set the desired speed in the range from 1 to 10 using the speed control knob **B5** and start the appliance by pressing the "START/PAUSE" button **B7**. The display **B1** will show the elapsed time. During operation, you may change the speed as necessary. When "60" appears on the display **B1**, the appliance will stop automatically. If you wish to stop the appliance sooner, press the ⏻ button **B6**. To pause the appliance temporarily or to resume operation, use the "START/PAUSE" button **B7**.

Recommended speed setting	Ingredients
Speed 1–4	Blending of very soft and soft ingredients (oranges, tomatoes, bananas, etc.), liquids, viscous sauces, etc.
Speed 5–7	Blending of harder ingredients such as carrots, etc., boiled grains, beans, soya beans, etc.
Speed 8–10	Blending of hard ingredients such as nuts, dry grains and dry beans, etc.

5. The "PULSE" button **B8** is used for crushing ice and for short pulse blending of smaller amounts of ingredients. When button **B8** is pressed, the appliance will run at maximum speed and the appliance will run as long as the button **B8** is pressed (however, no longer than 1 minute). When button **B8** is released, the appliance will stop.



Attention:

The maximum continuous operating time of the appliance is 1 minute. Then allow the appliance to cool down for 5 minutes.

6. After you have finished using the appliance, set the speed control knob **B5** to position 1, turn off the appliance using the ⏻ button **B6** and disconnect the power cord from the power socket. Make sure that the rotating parts have stopped rotating. Take the blending jar assembly off the motor unit **A3**. After emptying out the contents of the blending jar, remove the blade assembly **A2**.
7. Then clean all the used parts according to the instructions in chapter Cleaning and maintenance.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Before cleaning it, make sure that the appliance is turned off, disconnected from the power socket and that the rotating parts have stopped.
- Disassemble the appliance into its individual parts. Thoroughly wash the used accessories using warm water and neutral kitchen detergent. Then rinse them with clean water and allow them to dry naturally or dry them out thoroughly using a wiping cloth. All removable parts, except for the blade assembly **A2**, are suitable for washing in a dishwasher (in the upper rack).



Note:

For cleaning the blade assembly **A2**, you may use the included brush **A8**.



Attention:

When cleaning the blade assembly **A2**, be very careful not to injure yourself on its sharp edge.

- When you have finished using it, it is also possible to clean the appliance by filling the blending jar **A1** with clean water with the addition of a few drops of neutral kitchen detergent and running the appliance for 5 to 10 seconds. Then turn off the appliance, disconnect it from the power socket and disassemble it. Then thoroughly rinse the blade assembly **A2** and the blending jar **A1** under clean running water and allow it to dry naturally, or wipe it dry.
- To clean the outer surface of the motor unit **A3**, use a cloth lightly dipped in a weak detergent solution. After applying the detergent solution, wipe the surface with a cloth lightly dampened in clean water and then wipe dry.
- Never submerge the motor unit **A3** or the power cord in water or in any other liquid.
- Do not use solvents, cleaning products with an abrasive effect, etc. for cleaning the appliance. Otherwise, the surface coat of the appliance may be damaged.

- When not using the appliance, store it in a clean, dry place out of children's reach.
