#### IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE


### INTRODUCTION

The Sencor SIK 50 electric insect killer is an indispensable aid anywhere where there is an excessive amount mosquitoes and other annoying insects. It is equipped with two special 4W tubes emitting blue ultraviolet light, which attracts the insects inside, where they are subsequently killed by high voltage on the protective grill.

#### Several tips for effective operation

- 1) The insect killer should be located in a location where insects enter from the outdoors into a room and in locations, where the insects will react to the light of the insect killer.
- 2) The recommended installation height is up to 2 meters, but for reasons of easy operation and maintenance the lower it is the better and also because insect activity is higher near the floor (insect killers located at a height of 1.5 m are 4x to 10x more effective).
- 3) The best effect is achieved by locating the insect killer in a dark corner so that the blue light is more distinctive. The effectiveness of the insect killer can be negatively affected by the intensity of other light sources, whether artificial or day light so we recommend that it is located where there is a minimum concentration of these sources.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

#### **Putting into operation**

- 1) It is optimal to hang the electric insect killer using the loop in a dark corner.
- 2) Check that the voltage in your electricity grid corresponds to the voltage specified on the type label.
- 3) Insert the power plug into the power socket.
- 4) Move the main switch to position "1".




The product is not designed for outdoor use and in no case should it be exposed to for example rain. If you need to install it for example on the terrace, it is essential that you install it under the roof!

### Changing the light tube

- 1) First disconnect the insect killer from the power socket and move the main switch to position "0".
- 2) By turning remove the bottom of the insect killer.
- 3) Now remove the plastic cross protecting the tubes.
- 4) By pulling towards yourself carefully remove both the old tubes.
- 5) Insert new tubes into the socket.
- 6) Place the plastic cross back on the new tubes, so that all 4 ends sit on the plastic posts of the grate.
- 7) By turning, screw the bottom back on to the electric insect killer.

## **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**



#### Warning

Before cleaning disconnect this product from the power source.

- 1) Locate the electric insect killer above a rubbish bin.
- 2) Do not turn it upside down!
- Turn the bottom of the insect killer and carefully remove the lid the contents will fall into the bin.
- By turning, screw the bottom back on to the electric insect killer.



#### Warning

Never wash the product under running water.

To clean the outer parts of the product, use a soft cloth dipped in lukewarm water. Do not use aggressive cleaning products and solvents as this could damage the surface of the product.
